Antisemitism/Antizionism

A powerful group of hypocrites has subverted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and exploited its principles and institutions to demonize Israel and the Jewish people.

In December 1948, the members of the United Nations adopted two important statements – the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR) and the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide. Both were written in the shadow of the Holocaust, ostensibly to ensure that the horrors of Nazi Germany and its allies would not be repeated.

However, after 75 years, these idealistic texts and the institutions created to implement them are clearly a total failure, and worse – the language of human rights has been weaponized for the most vicious antisemitic attacks since the Holocaust. Real and horrible human rights abuses in Russia, China, Syria, Iran, Venezuela, Afghanistan, Africa, and elsewhere are all but ignored, while armies of haters march through university campuses and city streets attacking Jews, and chanting slogans labeling Zionists (most Jews) and Israelis as guilty of war crimes, genocide, and apartheid.

The U.N. Human Rights Council is a center for hate propaganda and 21st-century blood libels, accompanied by a powerful and corrupt industry of nongovernmental organizations (NGOs), led by Human Rights Watch (HRW) and Amnesty International. These organizations publish pseudoreports citing invented evidence (lies) painting Israel and self-determination for the Jewish people as "apartheid," and self-defense as "genocide." Israelis who were brutally slaughtered and kidnapped as hostages by Hamas are erased or reduced to token mentions used to claim "balance," and guickly forgotten. University programs advertised under the headings of "human rights and international law" are often staffed by propagandists who share and promote this form of hate.

Looking back over the past 75 years, the causes of this travesty are clearly visible. Not surprisingly, antisemitism is central, beginning with the Soviet Union and the Arab League. In U.N. debates on human rights and racism during the 1960s, when the U.S. and Israel condemned the USSR for oppressing its 3 million Jewish citizens, the Kremlin countered with attacks against Zionism. These forces produced the infamously antisemitic 1975 "Zionism is Racism" Resolution 3379 in the General Assembly. And although the resolution was repealed in 1991, the accompanying U.N. committees and funding mechanisms for demonizing Israel and any form of Jewish self-determination remain.

In 2001, the U.N. Commission on Human Rights, headed by Mary Robinson, revived the antisemitic attack at the World Conference Against Racism held in Durban, South Africa in September 2001. Representatives of 1,500 NGOs repeated accusations of war crimes, apartheid, and ethnic cleansing, as well as blocking representatives of "Zionist" NGOs from participating. The hate campaign gained momentum and visibility, backed by massive budgets. The U.N. Human Rights Council (renamed in 2006) has an automatic majority of states from the Organization of Islamic Cooperation and allied dictatorships, controlling the agenda and appointing officials, such as Francesca Albanese, the special rapporteur on the situation of human rights in the Palestinian Territory, and the members of a permanent Commission of Inquiry - a 21stcentury version of the Inquisition. Their ritual condemnations are parroted by journalists and U.N. officials, including the head of UNICEF and Secretary General António Guterres. For the most part, the hypocrites from European democracies add their votes to signal "solidarity" with the Palestinians, or, at best. abstain.

In parallel, organizations linked to Christian and Moslem religious frameworks have joined in singling out Israel. Under headings such as "liberation theology," church groups have combined classical theological antisemitism with the terminology (or slogans) of international law and embraced the myths of Palestinian victimhood. Israel (the Jewish State) is denied the right to self-defense against heinous pogroms, and the IDF is portrayed as bloodthirsty killers of children. Similarly, in mosques around the world, imams quote verses of the Quran that portray Jews as treacherous idolaters, and have adopted many of the Christian themes, particularly blood libels.

Human rights antisemitism is accompanied and amplified by the theology of the neo-Marxist left, which is focused on opposing "racist, capitalist, imperialist, colonial oppressors." Under slogans such as "intersectional solidarity" and DEI, (diversity, equality, and inclusion - except for Jews) these ideologues have conquered the leading universities, claiming to speak for ostensibly oppressed peoples (many of which are led by terror regimes) in the "global south," while Israel, particularly after the 1967 war, is branded as the tool of American and European imperialism. In this tortured version of morality and human rights, western nationalism, including Zionism, is automatically "evil," but Third World nationalism and "liberation" movements are good – the victims can never be unjust oppressors (even when they engage in indescribable brutality), and the "colonialists" cannot be righteous victims.

Top officials of organizations such HRW and Amnesty International are among the high priests of this ideology, replacing the universality that was declared to be the moral foundation of the post-Holocaust human rights movement in 1948. Ken Roth, the Oformer executive director of HRW, and other activists alienated from their Jewish backgrounds and harboring an obsessive hostility towards Israel and Zionism join the antisemites in demonizing Israel through the exploitation of human rights and international law. Backed with an annual budget of \$100 million, including evidence that Qatar is among Roth's main funders, the NGO role in the irrational hate directed at Israel is crucial. The results of this combination were highlighted a few weeks ago, when Danielle Haas, a longtime senior employee at HRW turned whistleblower, condemned the "years of politicization" on Israel, violating "basic editorial standards related to rigor, balance, and collegiality." As she wrote, HRW's response to the Oct. 7th Hamas massacre referenced "the 'context' of 'apartheid' and 'occupation' before blood was even dry on bedroom walls." Although Haas did not mention Ken Roth by name, his role was reflected in her description of the "shattered professionalism, abandoned principles of accuracy and fairness," and the multiple ways in which HRW has "surrendered its duty to stand for the human rights of all."

For these reasons and more, a powerful group of hypocrites has subverted the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and exploited its principles and institutions to demonize Israel and the Jewish people. The brief window of morality after the Holocaust has been slammed shut. Restoring these principles will require a long and consistent campaign, beginning with the replacement of the "experts" and officials that have installed themselves as the arbiters of human rights.

Antisemitism/Antizionism

"An antisemite is someone who hated me before I was born," Elie Wiesel, survivor of Auschwitz, said.

Antisemitism is a denial of humanity of the Jew. The reactions that occurred at Harvard in the wake of Oct. 7 considered Jews oppressors and, in some way, unworthy of human consideration.

In the calculus of an antisemite, Jews are both subhuman and superhuman – vermin who control the world. Common antisemitic rhetoric places Jews at the center of conspiracies, secretly controlling anything and everything: America, the banks, the Middle East, a vast colonialist enterprise, immigration, the Federal Reserve, NATO, and even Taylor Swift's concert tour schedule.

People hate Jews because they are communists, capitalists, foreigners, residents, immigrants, elitists, have strange ways, are unassimilated, too assimilated, bankroll the left (like George Soros) or bankroll the right (like Sheldon Adelson). People hate Jews because they are weak and stateless, or because they are Zionists and defend Israel.

This hate is justified in a number of ways, and it is never just because someone is Jewish.

One ideology common at Harvard is the colonialist settler ideology. Colonialists are people who come from one place, take a land, and now have two.

But, Jews are far from being colonialists. Jews come from Israel. In this ideology, the colonialists are almost always white, but the Jews in Israel are quite diverse. Colonialists do not share the land, but Israel gave the Sinai Peninsula back to Egypt and has made many separate offers to share their land with Palestinians – which the Palestinians rejected. Further, Jews were kicked out of Israel by one colonial power – Rome – and returned by overthrowing the rule of another – Britain.

Much of Harvard is captured by an ideology that centers oppression, but dividing all of the world into oppressor and oppressed is dangerous. Once you divide humanity by race or creed or nation into two camps – the good and the evil – you have adopted the mentality of the despot. This is bad for society, as well as for Jews.

Although many do so in ignorance, when people chant "from the river to the sea" the most natural interpretation of their calls is advocacy for territory without Israel, without Jews.

I have never heard of activists who are angry with China targeting Chinese restaurants in Paris, but when Hamas terrorists were recently arrested in Europe with plans to blow up Jewish institutions, they were not targeting Israel, but Jews. If someone is angry at Israel, they target Jewish synagogues, businesses, and restaurants – anything associated with Jews, anywhere in the world – no matter their relationship to Israel.

This enmity has deep roots.

I have a position at the Harvard Divinity School, and I often wonder whether we teach students that both the New Testament, and to a lesser extent the Koran, contain messages hostile to Jews. Do the students learn that Martin Luther said Jews "are a serpent's brood" and their synagogues should be burned, or how during periods like the Almohad persecution, Jews could accept Islam, flee, or die? How Christians persecuted and periodically murdered Jews for some 1,500 years?

Jews experienced more acceptance in Muslim lands, yet still were labeled impure, subjugated, and were often persecuted. Many of my congregants in Los Angeles were forced to flee Iran when the Shah fell in 1979 – their property confiscated, the leader of the community executed, and the Khomeini regime making clear they were unwelcome in the new Islamic republic. Having lost everything and escaping with their lives, years later, they still have nightmares.

Why all this hatred against one small people? We remained different, distinct. We would not become Christian or Muslim. We were outsiders, others, champions of diversity.

Moreover, Jewish culture – portable, book-focused, and one that venerates scholarship and learning – primes us for economies where information and mental agility lead to success. When you don't like someone, seeing them succeed magnifies the antipathy.

Finally, Jews introduced the idea of ethical monotheism – the moral demands that one God makes on human beings – to the western tradition. As Jewish essayist Maurice Samuel said, "no one likes an alarm clock"; Jews represent conscience and conscience is a disruptive and painful partner in our lives.

The energy and outrage Jews generate – making up 0.2 percent of the world population – is oddly disproportionate. Antisemitism is a wild, irrational eruption.

Harvard has a long and ignoble history of antisemitism, as Harvard President Claudine Gay said in her remarks to Harvard Hillel in October. It is time to admit it, confront it and overcome it. One can criticize policies without calling for the end to the only homeland Jews have ever known. One can demand a Palestinian state without globalizing the intifada – the term for a protest that previously resulted in over 110 suicide bombings that targeted buses, cafes, and malls.

If we cannot learn to argue civilly at Harvard, how can we have hope for the civility of other places in the world?

Jews gave the world a precious gift: the idea that each human being is an image of God. I pray that we all remember and honor that gift.

Israel Has Committed No War Crimes—Hamas Has Alan Dershowitz | January 3, 2024 Link to original artitcle <u>here</u>

Critics of Israel have charged the Jewish state with committing atrocities and even "genocide" in its ongoing war with Hamas. The South African government has even brought these charges before the International Court of Justice. The accusations are without merit: Israel has committed no war crimes in seeking to degrade and destroy Hamas in Gaza. Hamas, by contrast, has committed at least four categories of war crimes.

First, Hamas waged an aggressive war against Israel, crossing its border and murdering, raping, and kidnapping civilians. Second, it has targeted civilians with its rockets. Third, it has dressed its terrorists in civilian clothing, thus eliminating the important distinction between combatants and civilians. And fourth, it has used its own civilians as human shields.

Unlike Hamas, which began this war, Israel has acted in self-defense. Under international law it has the right and obligation to defend its citizens by all reasonable and lawful means.

In doing so, the Israel Defense Forces have made extraordinary efforts to target only combatants. Notwithstanding these efforts, Palestinian civilians have been killed, largely because Hamas has deliberately embedded its war machinery among civilians to produce dead bodies to display to the media.

Hamas-controlled health authorities have claimed about 22,000 Palestinians have been killed thus far. But they haven't distinguished between combatants and civilians. Israel claims to have killed approximately 7,000 combatants. Hamas claims that many of those killed were children and women. But they haven't revealed the ages of the dead children, whom the terror group defines as anyone under 19. Hamas actively recruits terrorists from the age of 13. This brutal strategy, itself a war crime, raises discomfiting questions about Hamas's fatality claims: An 18-year-old with an RPG or an assault weapon is as much a combatant as a 30-year-old.

The same is true of women. Hamas regards women as incapable of performing many roles, but one role

many are recruited to perform is that of terrorist and combatant. And so it can't be assumed that all of the women who have been killed were civilians. Then there are those who have been killed by "friendly fire"—including misfired rockets and bullets fired by Hamas against Palestinians who were trying to flee to safe areas.

Although it is impossible to know for certain how many actually innocent civilians have been killed, the number is certainly far lower than estimates put forward by Hamas and its supporters. Even if it is as high as 14,000, that would produce a ratio of civilians to combatants killed of roughly 2 to 1-that is, for every combatant killed, two civilians would have been killed.

If this ratio is close to being true, then Israel's record is far better than that of any other country in the history of modern urban warfare facing comparable enemies and tactics. Typical ratios of civilian to combatant deaths range from 3 to 1 to 10 to 1, as in the cases of Afghanistan, Iraq, Yemen, and Syria. And those ratios occur in situations where civilians aren't used as human shields.

This brings us to the law of war. The only requirement of proportionality under international law is that when combatants are targeted in areas where civilians are present, the value of the military target must be proportional to the number of anticipated civilian deaths. This highly subjective judgment can't be the basis of a war-crime prosecution, unless the judgment is utterly unreasonable. The 2-to-1 ratio is not only reasonable, but far better than that achieved by other armed forces facing comparable situations. Thus, were Israel to be prosecuted for violating the principle of proportionality, that would necessarily involve the application of a double standard against the Jewish state.

The charge of genocide made by South Africa is even less persuasive. Real genocides have taken place in the world today, especially in Africa. South Africa has been silent about these neighboring genocides. And it is weakening the term itself by

selectively politicizing it against Israel. Gaza has grown in population during the period in which genocide is charged. Israel has provided health care to Gazans in need of Israeli hospitals. It provided high-paying jobs in Israel to thousands of Gazans. These aren't the actions of a nation engaged in genocide.

Genocide is directed against an entire people, not just criminals and terrorists among them. To accuse Israel of genocide is to fail to distinguish between the legitimate military goal of ending a terrorist organization, such as Hamas, and the illegitimate goal of ending the existence of an entire ethnic or religious group.

The term genocide was coined to describe the Nazi effort to rid the world of all Jews. Accusing Israel of genocide is a form of Holocaust denial, since no one even suggests that Israel has extermination camps, gas chambers, or other mechanisms that exemplified the Holocaust. If Israel were to be found guilty of genocide, the very meaning of that horrible crime would be diluted beyond recognition. It would then apply to the US bombing of Hiroshima, the British bombing of Dresden, and the killing of civilians during the Afghan, Iraqi, and Syrian military actions. Every civilian death in wartime is a tragedy, and Hamas knew it was signing the death warrants of many civilians when it attacked Israel and then hid its war machinery among Gaza's civilian population. The death of a human shield is the legal and moral responsibility of those who deliberately placed civilians in harm's way. Consider the following example: A bank robber starts shooting at customers. When the police arrive, the robber grabs one of the customers and uses her as a human shield. A policeman, in an effort to save the lives of customers, tries to shoot the robber. But the hostage suddenly makes a move, and then the policeman's bullet hits and kills her. Under the law of every nation, it is the hostage taker, not the policeman who is guilty of killing the hostage, even though the bullet that killed her came from the policeman's gun.

It is Hamas and its Iranian patrons that should be on trial, not the victims of Hamas barbarism.

Parashat Shemot (Exodus 1:1-6:1) Rabbanit Dr. Adina Sternberg, Faculty of Matan, Efrata, and Bar Ilan Midrasha

Many times, our life experiences affect our ability to deal with new challenges.

Our parsha tells us that when God turns to Moshe to appoint him to undertake a mission, Moshe refuses: "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and free the Israelites from Egypt?". Many have addressed the meaning of Moshe's refusal, contemplating whether his refusal is emotional and based on a certain modesty, or whether it is logical and based on a reasonable assessment of reality. We may add another point of view, pondering the connection between Moshe's refusal and his past experiences. Reading between the lines we may detect an echo of the first time Moshe tried to save a fellow Hebrew from the hands of Egyptians.


When Moshe protected his fellow Hebrew from the Egyptian oppressor, he received two responses. The first response came from the Hebrews themselves, who rejected Moshe's help: "Who made you chief and ruler over us?". These words did not only express the Hebrew offender's wish to get Moshe off his back, they were also a rejection of Moshe's attempt to help his brothers. The fact that this incident also forced him to flee Egypt in fear of retaliation did not contribute to his failing confidence. Moshe has learned his lesson, and next time he is asked to step up, he prefers to step down.

Rashi also connects these two stories. On Moshe's realization: "then the matter is known!" Rashi comments that now Moshe understood why the People of Israel were still enslaved; They deserved it! This is also how Rashi explains Moshe's refusal. Moshe is not only wary of his abilities to free the People of Israel, he is wary of whether or not they deserve to be freed.


Moshe's past experience of trying to help his fellow brothers has taught him that they don't want, or don't deserve, his help. And yet, God expects him to ignore the lessons he has learned, to let go of past trauma, to reject conclusions based on incidental experiences, and do what is right. Salvation is based on the belief in change – the ability of individuals to change, or a people to change and therefore the belief in the potential of a changed reality.

These days, we pray we all can change. We pray we can shed constricting beliefs regarding ourselves and our fellow Jews. We pray that our leaders will re-evaluate the reality time and again, and that they believe in Israel's potential and abilities - they must make sure they don't stagnate, but learn to move forward toward our joint goals. And we pray to God to bring us salvation, changing our reality for the better.

Homeland Concert


When an ambitious Israeli singer gets the opportunity to perform at the famed amphitheater in Caesarea, they know they've "made it" in Israel. Many of Israel's greatest live musical moments have taken place in this ancient open-air theater, under the stars. is a magical place to see a show.

So when producer Talya Yarom came up with an idea to bring together 1,000 musicians and singers to play in support of those held hostage in Gaza, she knew Caesarea was the place to do it.

The result was "Homeland Concert" – a powerful anthem calling for the release of the hostages, with lyrics by legendary Israeli lyricist Ehud Manor. Entitled "HaBayta" (Home), the song was originally recorded by Yardena Arazi in 1983, serving as a call for the IDF to withdraw from Lebanon at the time of the First Lebanon War.

"The concept was a national project," Yarom told The Times of Israel. "The nation is crying to the world, "Bring Them Home." She said she wanted a grand outdoor production "to warm everyone's frozen hearts" after the tragic events of October 7.

A grand production, indeed. The Times of Israel reports that Yarom put out a call for 1,000 musicians on social media – and got nearly 2,000 responses. All of the musicians rehearsed at home, and met together for the first time in Caesarea on December 18. The final product is truly an inspiring experience; an uplifting musical outpouring of despair and love, spreading light in the midst of today's very dark times.


