By taking Israel to the ICJ, the ANC will be killing two birds with one stone

In 1958, Mao Zedong decreed that Chinese citizens should destroy the humble sparrow because the birds were eating much-needed grain in a country where hunger was a constant companion.

Dutifully, people took up the challenge, shooting the birds, breaking up nests, smashing eggs, and beating drums to scare the animals and prevent them from landing to rest. After two years, hundreds of millions of birds were dead as the sparrow approached extinction across China.

But destroying the sparrow resulted in one of the most devastating famines in recent history, killing 15-40 million Chinese citizens (the exact number remains subject to debate).

Why? Because it turned out that sparrows didn't just eat grain. They also ate insects, including locusts with an appetite for crops. With its major predator effectively side-lined, the locust roamed rampant across China.

This is the law of unintended consequences, something that the South African government is about to discover.

Israel is set to appear before the International Court of Justice and South Africa is thrilled with itself.

This seems to be the perfect opportunity for the African National Congress (ANC) to reclaim some of its lost luster. A chance to showcase their values and their deep-seated concern for citizens of the world. Well, aside from Zimbabweans, the people of Iran, Muslims in China, and those of Ukraine, Cuba, Sudan, and so on. And well, aside from their own people of South Africa who boast the highest youth unemployment rate in the world, horrendous crime, poor healthcare, and a crippling power crisis.

Finally, they can prove to South Africans, ahead of the 2024 national elections, that they are able to follow through on something. Israel, according to President Cyril Ramaphosa, is guilty of genocide. They are indiscriminately killing civilians in Gaza and they need to be urgently stopped.

The legal team that has been assembled by the ANC is a formidable one. Well versed, and well respected. Leaders in the field.

There are a few reasons, however, that make the case against Israel far from a "slam dunk."

Hamas, in its charter, in its actions, and in its words vows to kill every Jew in the region (literally the definition of genocide).

Hamas has affirmed its actions of October 7 and has publicly stated that it will do it "Again and again and again."

Hamas is still holding hostages, one of them baby Kfir who, if alive, will have celebrated his first birthday this week.

Hamas mass raped, tortured, and kidnapped women and killed children and civilians as they lay in their beds.

Hamas could end all killings by returning the hostages and surrendering.

They have used billions of dollars intended for aid to build a tunnel system purely for terror; amassed and manufactured weapons still being used against Israelis towns; and "educated" the children of Gaza to hate Jews.

They used hospitals and schools as military bases.

They prevented civilians from moving to safety.

They launched rockets towards Israel, 20% of which fall back into Gaza itself, killing civilians.

Add further, the fact that there was a ceasefire on October 6, which Hamas broke, and the fact that it continues to shoot rockets at Israel. Rockets that but for the Iron Dome would likely have killed thousands of Israelis.

Israel will unquestionably have the required proof of the above.

The court will need to consider the actions of the parties; consider the facts and if there indeed is a case of genocide, who the victim might be?

What does this have to do with sparrows in China?

The answer is "unintended consequences." The reality is that Israel has long struggled to be heard. The overwhelming support of Western media for the Palestinian cause and of academics and so-called progressives who align with the "oppressed," has created a world of confusion. The repetition of "genocide," of "apartheid," of "ethnic cleansing" has worked to silence alternative voices, so indicated by the nebulous response to the rape of Israelis, to the taking of hostages, and to the relentless attack on Israeli cities.

By taking Israel to the ICJ, South Africa will finally provide Israel with a platform and an opportunity to be heard.

Algorithms that until recently would have ensured that haters of Israel are sheltered from a counter view, media who might have avoided presenting alternative facts, and academics who have been tripped up in an Orwellian world of their own making will hear it from Israel.

It will not all go Israel's way. There will be sound bites too, that will reflect poorly on some Israeli ministers. There will be incidents of war that are ugly. And there will be the exposure of terrible Palestinian suffering. And yet, by the conclusion and presentation of the facts, South Africa would have provided a platform that Israel has long sought. In doing so, the ANC will not only assist Israel but will expose itself as being the self-serving and hypocritical organization that many know it to be.

Antisemitism at Harvard Started Long Before Claudine Gay Nancy Katz

Orwell's Intellectuals

Offensive slurs, blindness to Jews' history of oppression and anti-Israel bias aren't new, but one thing is different today

Harvard's antisemitism problem started long before Claudine Gay. Now it's attracting public outcry, with alumni and donors severing ties. For me, though, it's an old story.

I joined the Kennedy School faculty in 1998. At that time, being Jewish was easy. Twenty-five percent of the faculty was Jewish. Every building on the K-School campus bore the name of a Jewish benefactor.

Jewish practice was normalized. No one expressed concern when I canceled class on Rosh Hashanah or Yom Kippur. During Passover, cafeteria staff placed a box of matzah on the lunch counter for Jews to help themselves. Okay, some years the box of matzah appeared a week before the holiday and some years a week after, but why quibble? It was a thoughtful gesture.

I savored this sense of belonging. Growing up, I heard my father's stories of antisemitism in academia. My dad was a professor at Boston University Medical School back when it was a Protestant institution. He said he was the first Jew to be appointed a full clinical professor of medicine, but "far from the first Jew to deserve it." He was responsible for selecting each year's crop of interns and residents. The dean used to call my father into his office and reprimand him for the number of Jews he selected, sputtering that B.U. risked becoming known as "a Jewish school."

The first hint of trouble arose in 2002 at a faculty cocktail party. The topic of discussion was whether the US should topple Saddam Hussein in Iraq. An esteemed colleague revealed he had penned an op-ed arguing against invasion. He said he'd like the piece to run in the Wall Street Journal, but that wouldn't happen because the newspaper was "controlled by the Jews."

I was stunned. A prominent Harvard faculty member was a conspiracy theorist? His comment was so bizarre that I didn't know what to do with it. I simply

made a mental note to give him a wide berth.

A couple of years later, another warning shot. More serious this time, because it involved an institutional mindset rather than individual prejudice. I wanted to bring Natan Sharansky to the K-School, to address the Institute of Politics (IOP). He had just published a highly acclaimed book, The Case For Democracy.

The IOP declined my request because "we already had one Israeli speaker in the past year." Nonplussed, I responded that two Israelis in one year was not disproportionate representation. The IOP hosted at least 30 speakers annually.

They countered: Sharansky could speak, but not alone. He had to be paired on stage with a Palestinian for "balance." I argued that Sharansky was an international hero worthy of stand-alone billing. Furthermore, his book wasn't about the Palestinian conflict.

Ultimately, the IOP relented and Sharansky appeared alone. The event was a success, but the process was sobering. I gained insight into the IOP's view of Israelis, and it felt like a caricature. They saw Israelis exclusively through the lens of the Palestinian conflict.

My unease escalated in 2006 when I was appointed faculty representative to the Diversity Committee. At our first meeting, the students listed target populations: African Americans, Hispanics, Native Americans, women, gays, and lesbians, and the physically handicapped. I suggested they consider adding Jews. No, the students said. Religion was outside their scope.

I pointed out that Judaism is not just a religion but also a race. The students demurred. Even if Jews are a race, they said, Jews do not qualify as a historically marginalized one. I pushed further, but the students wouldn't have it. Jews, they insisted, are more than adequately represented among the elite, and belong to "the oppressor class."

The students' ignorance of history was appalling. Also, it was chilling to realize how they saw me. I thought of myself as an ally, but they felt my boot

on their neck. I realized the DEI framework could marginalize, even demonize, Jewish students.

My relationship with Harvard was shifting from identification to alienation. Then came the coup de grace. An essay entitled "The Israel Lobby and US Foreign Policy" appeared on the Faculty Research Working Papers website. In it, my old boss Stephen Walt and his co-author from the University of Chicago, John Mearsheimer, asserted that American Jews twist US foreign policy to serve Israel's interests. A Jewish colleague observed that the paper "read like the Protocols of the Elders of Zion." "The Israel Lobby" felt like a personal assault. It painted me, a supporter of Israel, as an enemy of the public good.

I asked my boss, the academic dean, to move the paper to Walt's personal page at the K-School. Featuring it on the shared page appeared to give Harvard's imprimatur to antisemitic conspiracy theories. The dean refused.

As a social psychologist, I didn't feel knowledgeable enough to dismantle Walt's argument. I reached out to pro-Israel political scientists at the K-School, hoping they would draft a rebuttal. They declined, explaining that the US-Israel relationship was not their specialty and they didn't want to "look stupid." Of course, the US-Israel relationship was not Walt's specialty either, as his focus was security studies, yet that hadn't stopped him from speaking as an authority. My Jewish colleagues were no braver than I was - we kept our heads down.

I longed to hear the dean condemn Walt's antisemitism publicly. Or at a faculty meeting. Or in a private meeting. I never heard it. Feeling utterly demoralized, I realized it was time to move on.

The paper was later published as a bestselling book. Did anyone suffer repercussions? Walt told me he was showered with approval from non-Jews, and even some Jews. He described the experience as deeply affirming.

The K-School took a fundraising hit of some \$30 million, according to insider estimates. But within a few years Jewish benefactors were back to making large gifts, including a new building. It seemed nothing was learned.

Which is why I see a bright spot in the current mess. At least this time Jews are exercising their rights with impact. It might backfire, it might wound innocent bystanders, it might serve outside interests. But finally Jews are drawing a red line in the sand regarding antisemitism, and insisting "no more."

One of the biggest mistakes of critics of Israel's war against Hamas in Gaza is attempting to compare the war to a past modern war (post-WWII) or a battle that is not what Israel is conducting in Gaza.



"The first, the supreme, the most far-reaching act of judgment that the statesman and commander have to make is to establish by that test the kind of war on which they are embarking; neither mistaking it for, nor trying to turn it into, something that is alien to its nature."

- Carl von Clausewitz, On War

The IDF is fighting a full-scale war against a terrorist military of over 30,000 fighters with a massive arsenal of rockets, who has spent decades and millions of dollars digging an underground world of hundreds of miles of tunnels woven into the civilian society and with the design to reverse engineer the current laws of war (lawfare) to achieve their strategic goals.

Unlike other battles, the Hamas strategic goals are not to hold terrain or defeat Israel's military but to sacrifice their civilians (so not human shields, but human sacrifices) to cause the international community to force Israel to stop their counterattack.

No modern military has faced 13,000 plus rockets being launched over their heads at their homes while conducting their war/battle/operation.

Nor since World War II has a military fought in a situation where hundreds (now 136) of their own citizens (to include babies, women, elderly) are being illegally held hostage inside the combat area and a strategic factor in their timeline of the war.

Israel is not fighting in one city. It is fighting in five major cities. It is fighting a real and definable existential threat to the survival of their citizens and nation.

IMO, the fact is that Israel has followed the laws of war, has implemented civilian harm mitigation steps that no military has implemented in modern urban battles and people still attempt a moral equivalence with out of context battles.

Parashat Bo (Exodus 10:1-13:16) Rabbanit Dr. Adina Sternberg, Faculty of Matan, Efrata, and Bar Ilan Midrasha

In their formal negotiation, Moses and Aharon in the name of God present two demands from Pharaoh. The first demand is: "Let My people go that they may celebrate a festival for Me in the wilderness". A bit later this demand is refined: "Let us go, we pray, a distance of three days into the wilderness to sacrifice to our God". The second demand, which can be understood as a repetition of the first one, or as an expansion of it, is: ""Let My people go that they may worship Me".

We notice that Moses never says they are planning to return. He does not request a leave for three days, but rather that the sacrifice be at a distance of a three-day walk. The request: "that they may worship Me" implies that the People of Israel will be substituting worshiping Pharaoh with worshiping God. The redemption from Egypt, like redemption of land, entails freeing – a people or a land – from the stronghold of one owner to the possession of another owner from one's family. The goal of becoming worshipers of God is the reason they could never promise to return.

And yet the first official demand does not refer to transferring loyalty of slavery or servitude, but rather to the festive celebration. The Torah uses the same word both for holiday celebrations and for other festivities which include eating and dancing. Does this mean one is supposed to have festive celebrations on the holidays? Our Sages raised that possibility but concluded that the direct meaning of the command is to sacrifice to God, as is implied from the parallel requests.

However, the Torah uses the word that implies festivities. We are led to believe this is the foremost purpose of leaving Egypt, to celebrate with God. So much so, that the rabbis of the school of Beit Hillel said there is a certain preference to the hagiga sacrifice, the sacrifice of the celebration, over other sacrifices brought on the holidays. According to them, this celebration preceded the giving of the Torah and therefore its importance is magnified.

We can see that receiving the Torah, through which we shall worship God, comes only after festive celebrations with God. Despite substituting one "commander" with another, God wants us to have the correct frame of reference, one where receiving the Torah is a festival, with two sides rejoicing in the event and coming together in holy covenant.

The Torah has many challenging and constricting aspects, but before encountering them, and as part of encountering them, we also celebrate the giving of the Torah. Just like an individual's Bar or Bat Mitzvah, the people of Israel will begin their new life, with fresh meaning and purpose with a festive celebration

Magic Formula for Peace in the Middle East



The UN's International Court of Justice (ICJ) is illegitimate, and lacks the moral authority to adjudicate Israel's just war of self-defense.

Allegations of genocide against trarel are bizarre and without foundation in fact or lwa, and the ICJ proceedings are a dangerous farce. The UN General Assembly, who appoints ICJ judges, is dominated by dictatorships and riddled with antisemilistim. Therefore by definition, those judges lack the moral authority to stand in judgment over any democracy, especially lorad.

The UM and its institutions have increasingly been hijacked by undemocratic societies to advance objectives that threaten freedom, peace, and prosperity in the world. The majority of countries making up the General Assembly and UN Human Rights Council (HRC) are repressive, autoritarian regimes.

Consider that of the 193 members of the UN General Assembly only 84 are ranked as free societies, according to Freedom House. Of that of the 47 members of the UN Human Rights Council (whose very reason for existence is to protect and uphold human rights) only 13 can be defined as fully economically and politically free, according to the Social Research Foundation Global Freedom Scores.

That makes the ICJ case against Israel a theater of the absurd - where a majority of non-free societies are weaponsing a UN platform to undermine the self-defense rights of a liberal democracy. Allow that precedent to continue and the outlook for freedom in the world is dire.


