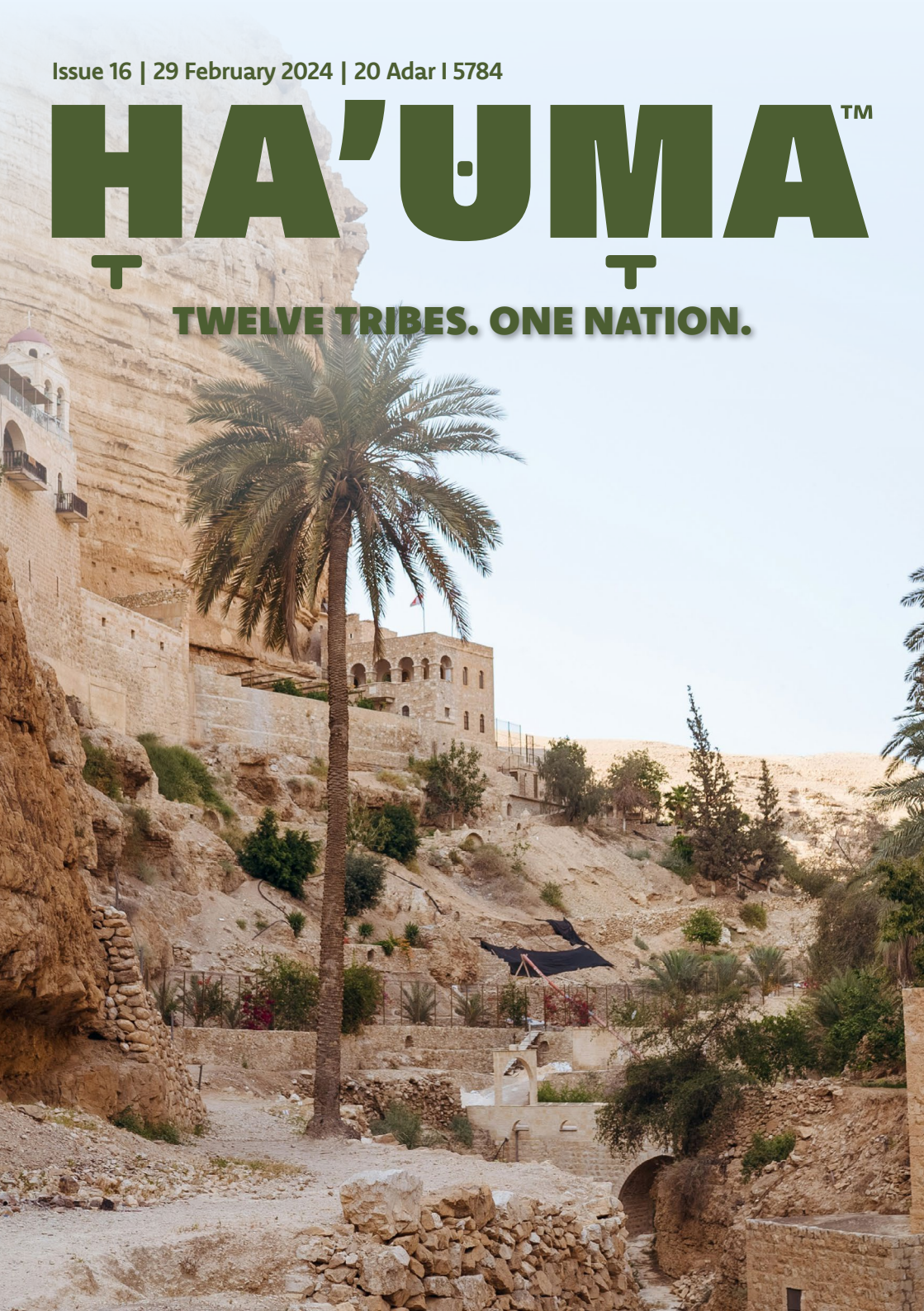

# Glossary of HA'UMA Categories

- **Featured Articles and Posts** – Editors' Picks of the most compelling articles and posts of the week.
- **Advocacy** – Calls for action.
- **Antisemitism/Antizionism** – Instances of antisemitism and antizionism, separate or combined.
- **Bring Them Home** – Posts about the plight of Israel's hostages held by Hamas terrorists.
- **Double Standards** – Instances when Israel and Jews are subject to a double standard. So prevalent it deserves its own category.
- **Hall of Champions** – Famous and not famous, Jewish and non-Jewish, supporters of Israel and Jews from around the world.
- **Hamas Lies** – Exposés of the many instances of Hamas's cruelty and war crimes.
- **Israel Truths** – Posts that express a positive truth about Israel and Israel's actions in the war.
- **Lawfare** – Important legal issues, such as how international law relates to the Israel-Hamas war and lawsuits against antisemitism on college campuses.

- **Satire** – Humor, dark and light, about the situation.
- **Sounds of Music** – Music videos that capture the spirit of the times and from Israel.
- **The Situation** – A catch-all category for posts that don't fit into the other categories.
- **Thousands of Words** – These are evocative graphics and memes, pictures that speak "a thousand words."
- **UNhinged** – Though the UN was established with the noblest of intentions, it has since become an inveterately antisemitic organization that often actively supports the enemies of Israel, Jews, and the civilized world.

In the pantheon of international organizations that treat Israel with a mix of disdain and indifference, the International Committee for the Red Cross (ICRC) is a cut above the rest.

It's not the most loathsome NGO – the United Nations Relief and Welfare Agency (UNRWA) owns that title – but it has been the most hypocritical organization for the longest period of time. The ICRC has a track record of shamelessly hyping its humanitarianism amid conflicts while practicing a systematic indifference to Jewish life.

The organization did lots of posturing after the October 7th massacre, mostly lamenting the 'humanitarian crisis' in Gaza that, of course, was precipitated by Hamas. The notable exception to the pattern of ignoring Jewish victims of war was a Red Cross representative lecturing families of Israelis being held hostage they need to "think about the Palestinian side."

The week after, Hadassah International asked ICRC president Mirjana Spoljaric, "Has the Red Cross ever before failed to care for hostages and victims of armed aggression in such a blatant way, or is this treatment reserved for individuals abducted from Israel?"

The answer is: indeed, it has reserved such treatment for Israelis. The ICRC has a rich history of going to great lengths to ignore Jewish suffering and getting rewarded for it.

In 1944, the group was awarded the Nobel Prize "for the great work it has performed during the war on behalf of humanity." However, the ICRC hid from The Nobel Committee and the entire world that it was aware of the Nazi extermination of Jews and did nothing. It knew about the 'Final Solution' but said nothing.

In 1943, the group decided to try to send food, medicine, and clothing to deportees in Nazi-dominated countries. It failed, and blamed Allied civilian authorities for failing to provide documents allowing them to pass through their war blockade.

The ICRC did muster the energy to issue transit

papers intended for war refugees traveling to haven countries to thousands of ex-Nazis, including war criminals such as Joseph Mengele and Adolph Eichmann. Past ICRC president Peter Mauer claimed the group failed as a "humanitarian organization because it had lost its moral compass. It failed ... by responding to the outrageous with standard procedures. It looked on helplessly and silently."

The question is, when it comes to Jews and Israelis if the ICRC has a moral compass at all. It took the ICRC 50 years to admit Israel's Magen David Adom into its ranks because its logo is the Star of David. And the ICRC's treatment of Israeli hostages – and their rationalization for such treatment – is hardly different than that of Jewish victims of the Nazis received.

The ICRC persistently took to social media and news outlets to blame Israel – wrongly – for bombing al-Shifa hospital. At the same time, security camera footage from the facility makes it clear the ICRC knew it was being used to confine hostages.

Fighters dragging the hostages can be seen interacting freely with medical personnel at the hospital in case anyone still tries to argue that hospital officials have plausible deniability. As some have pointed out, there was no way for the hostages to get to Shifa without being taken past several other hospitals on the way, so they were not brought in for medical care.

The Red Cross was no stranger to Shifa. For example, on November 6 and 7, it boasted of ICRC caravans transporting supplies to Shifa and patients from Shifa. They were aware of the material needs of the hospital and, therefore, what was being used daily. ICRC doctors and surgeons around Gaza were in contact with colleagues at Shifa.

Meanwhile, the ICRC had no qualms about portraying Israeli troops as a constant threat to medical personnel or would-be butchers or going on Al Jazeera to remind the IDF of its obligations to the hospitals that Hamas was already misusing. Indeed, the ICRC's partnership with Shifa is a point of pride for the organization.

None of this prevented the ICRC from taking credit for transporting the first wave of Israeli hostages Hamas released. As the Middle East Forum's Gregg Roman notes: "The Red Cross has conducted itself similarly since Hamas took Israeli hostages. The Red Cross gained much acclaim for bringing Israeli hostages home after they were released. However, the Red Cross played no part in the negotiations that led to the release and made no effort to visit the hostages while they were imprisoned."

This is in stark contrast to past hostage crises. During the Iranian hostage crisis, the Red Cross visited the occupied US embassy in Tehran. When 72 Japanese hostages were kidnapped by guerrilla forces in Peru in 1996, the Red Cross provided food and medical assistance. When New York Times reporter David Rohde was held by the Taliban in 2008, the Red Cross delivered him a letter from his wife. When more than 240 hostages were taken from Israel, however, the Red Cross did nothing.

Meanwhile, the ICRC still hasn't found a way to deliver lifesaving medicine to the remaining hostages. ICRC spokesman Jason Straziuso told the media:

"We don't have superpowers. We can only take humanitarian action when the authorities in a given area give us the permission."

Spoljaric asserted that pressuring Hamas would be ineffective and jeopardize the ICRC's neutrality.

Yet on December 9, 2023, a truck carrying medical aid for Gazans from the International Committee of the Red Cross arrived at the Nasser Medical Hospital in Khan Younis. This month, Israeli Defense Forces drove Hamas from the facility. The terrorists left behind a massive amount of ammunition and weaponry. Nearby, medications given to the ICRC to deliver to Jewish hostages weeks before sat undelivered and unopened.

What a fitting symbol of the decades-long relationship between the Red Cross and the Jewish people.

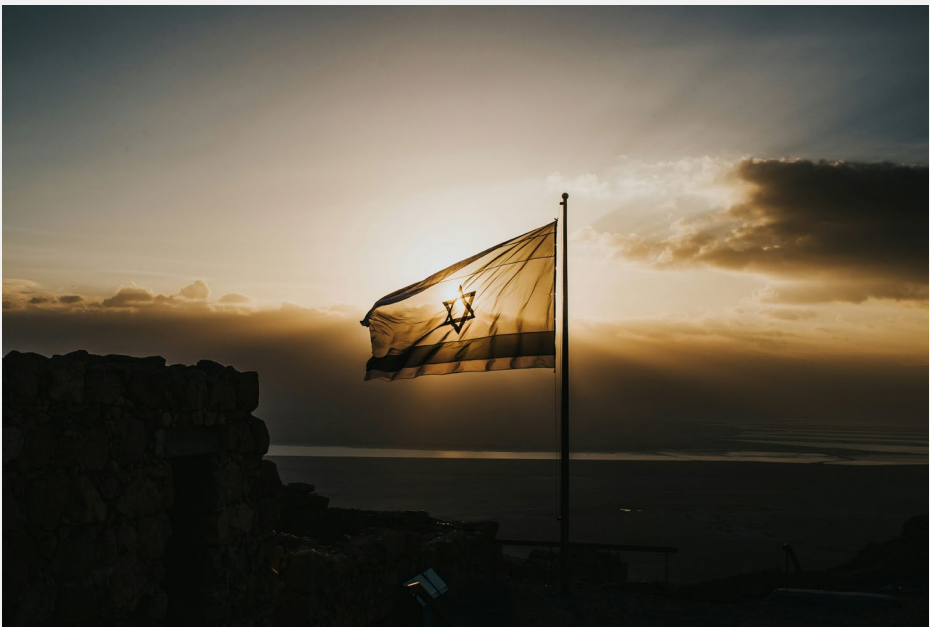

In “The Goals of the War in Gaza – and the Strategy for Achieving Them,” published by the Institute for National Security Studies in Tel Aviv, my friend Azar Gat provides an excellent guide to Israel’s internal national security debate. A Tel Aviv University political science professor and military history scholar, Gat sketches in unadorned terms Israel’s war aims and strategy. He also briskly evaluates the major doubts about the government’s plans and the leading alternatives. His compelling conclusion is that Israel’s principal objectives – destruction of Hamas’ military and governmental capabilities and liberation of the hostages – “are vital and can be achieved simultaneously.” Gat can insist on the unity of Israel’s goals because he understands them in context and tempers expectations in light of the harsh realities of Middle East politics in general and of Gaza in particular.

On Oct. 7, with Hamas jihadists rampaging through Israel’s southern border communities and perpetrating horrific war crimes, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu proclaimed that Israel was at war. This reflected a decisive change in the Jewish state’s strategic orientation.

Since Hamas’ violent 2007 ouster of the Palestinian Authority from Gaza, the terrorist organization’s periodic rocket bombardments of Israeli civilians and civilian infrastructure prompted Israel to undertake several military incursions into Gaza to degrade Hamas’ capabilities and restore quiet. The jihadists’ Oct. 7 savagery shattered the comforting illusion – shared by Israel’s governing coalition and opposition, military experts, and people – that the Jewish state could live with Hamas ruling Gaza. To eliminate Hamas’ capacity to govern and wage war, Netanyahu’s war cabinet – joined by the opposition’s two most experienced national security figures – prepared a major ground offensive.

Initial domestic skepticism focused on the Israel Defense Forces’ ability to maneuver in Gaza’s tightly packed urban areas. Yet, writes Gat, “it has become clear, and not only to the surprise of the skeptics, that the IDF – both regular and reserve forces – is functioning at an extraordinary level through tight coordination, which may be unsurpassed by any other army in the world, among ground forces and the air force combined with other combat units and intelligence capabilities.” Hamas’ ruthlessness and readiness provoked more skepticism. In flagrant violation of the international laws

of war, the jihadists embedded their forces in cities. Only after the fighting had begun did Israel discover the intricacy, sophistication, and extent of the hundreds of miles of tunnels Hamas built under Gaza’s civilian population and the enormous quantity of munitions and other military equipment the terrorist organization had amassed. “And nevertheless, the IDF gained control over Gaza City and the northern Strip and broke the organized defense of Hamas’ battalions and its brigades in the field,” reports Gat, “and the IDF is close to a similar achievement – despite challenging conditions and the spreading public despondency in relation to the perceived ‘treading water’ – in Khan Yunis.”

While Palestinian casualties have been staggering owing to Hamas’ conversion of urban areas into battlefields, Israel’s successes have come with far fewer fallen Israeli soldiers – under 235 at mid-month when Gat’s analysis was published – than expected.

Critics in Israel, nevertheless, have advocated several alternatives to Israel’s ground campaign. Gat finds none of them persuasive.

Some proposed a comprehensive siege of Gaza that would within weeks or perhaps months compel Hamas to surrender or provoke Palestinians to topple the terrorists. But, Gat argues, “the world and in particular the United States will not allow the starvation of ‘the state of Gaza.’” Furthermore, to expect that “the people of Gaza could rise up and overthrow an organization as armed, fanatical, and determined as Hamas is no less a dream detached from reality.”

Others have advocated discrete, small-scale raids accompanied by air power targeting Hamas’ infrastructure. Given the jihadists’ substantial capabilities, Gat argues, surgical strikes without controlling territory would produce “an endless war of attrition, with the potential for no fewer casualties, a decline of Israeli morale, and a decisive moral victory for Hamas.” That approach would also guarantee the continuation of Hamas’ rocket fire while relinquishing the means to end it.

Others still seek the war’s immediate end. They maintain that Israel cannot achieve more than it already has, or it has achieved enough, and they generally favor aggressive efforts to secure a deal with Hamas to save the hostages.

Gat poses and answers the difficult question: "What possible deal, as a practical matter, is on the table, and to what is it possible and necessary to agree?" Israel's war cabinet and a significant majority of the public are prepared to accept a ceasefire of a month or two in exchange for the hostages' release. A deal of this sort, he believes, could free dozens of the surviving elderly among the approximately 130 whom Hamas has not released. However, Gat emphasizes, Hamas has persisted in demanding "a ceasing of the war - not the fighting." That entails the IDF's withdrawal from Gaza, Hamas' return to power (even international guarantees of its wellbeing), and a captives deal of "everyone for everyone," which would require Israel to release thousands of hardened jihadists.

Striking a deal "at any price," which means acquiescing to Hamas' outrageous conditions, would bring about a "crushing national defeat," states Gat. "It is necessary to make a supreme effort and be ready to pay a high price to rescue as many hostages as possible, but Israel's surrender on existential questions is not an option."

Such a surrender would reverberate to Israel's great detriment throughout the Middle East. "The Palestinians and Arab public opinion - inclined, in any case, to the 'axis of resistance' - will back Hamas" while "Israel's potential allies in the Arab Middle East will be compelled to silence themselves and draw back," maintains Gat. Hamas will reassert control, rearm, rebuild military infrastructure, and renew indiscriminate rocket attacks on Israeli civilian populations. Having sustained heartbreaking losses with nothing to show for it, Israel will be ill disposed to mobilize again for war against Hamas. And the United States will be decidedly less inclined to green-light another round of devastating urban warfare.

The biggest cost to Israel, emphasizes Gat, would be the destruction of its deterrence - that is, the perception that it can and will strike swiftly and decisively. Hamas will have proved itself able to survive a concerted Israeli offensive and willing to subject Gazans to massive collateral damage. What would deter Hamas in the future from attacking Israel? What would deter Hezbollah and other regional jihadists from redoubling their fortifications in towns and cities and stockpiling arms for deadlier assaults on Israel's civilian population?

Without the deterrence that has served as a cornerstone of the nation's strategic culture since the country's birth in 1948, Israel will lose the long periods of relative peace and quiet that have allowed it to build a flourishing society in a dangerous neighborhood. Instead, it will face a draining and debilitating multi-front war against an array of Iranian-backed Islamists seeking its utter destruction.

This constellation of costs, culminating with the withering of its deterrence, "is the source of the deep and justified feeling in Israel that the war in Gaza is an existential war," writes Gat.

"What is the 'victory' that Israel can realistically achieve in the war against Hamas?" Gat asks, "and what apparently will not be possible to achieve?" Undistracted by Netanyahu's damaging political slogan of "absolute victory," Gat asserts that Israel can destroy Hamas' military leadership, fighting forces, and infrastructure and thwart its reemergence as Gaza's dominant power. This includes dismantling key nodes of Hamas' vast tunnel network - "munitions workshops, weapons and food stockpiles, and command and control centers" along with the energy sources that power communications, lighting, and ventilation. Israel can also correct what Gat regards as the nation's only strategic error since Oct. 7 by establishing control over the Philadelphi Corridor on Gaza's Egyptian border, through which Hamas has smuggled immense amounts of materials crucial to its military operations.

Hamas' total elimination, however, is not attainable. Following Israel's ground campaign, Gat argues, Hamas will continue to live in many Gazans' hearts. It will persist as a guerilla force. From time to time, the jihadists will launch volleys of rockets into Israel. But Israel will no longer be threatened by tens of thousands of entrenched jihadists possessing tens of thousands of rockets.

Unfortunately, battlefield success will not translate into a political solution for what ails Gaza. Despite its manifest flaws, the least awful option for "the day after" involves Israel maintaining overall security responsibility for Gaza. Moderate Gulf Arabs, the United States, and Europe must cooperate in reconstructing the war-torn territory. And Gaza should be administered by an "upgraded Palestinian Authority" that, like the PA in Judea and Samaria, enables Israeli forces to maneuver adroitly as needed against Hamas terrorists.

This astringent conclusion is not for want of imagination or empathy. To the contrary, it takes seriously local hearts and minds and reckons with the region's baleful geopolitical exigencies. In the Middle East, writes Gat, "there exist only bad options and much worse ones."

What is true of the Middle East is especially true of Gaza.

### Parashat Ki Tisa (Exodus 30:11-34:35)

When turning to the crisis we encounter in this week's parshah, we can apprehend it as we would a marital crisis. In this parshah, we encounter one of the biggest breaches between God and the nation He took out of Egypt. If we criticize Amalek for being the first nation to go against God's people after the exodus, we can view the sin of the Golden Calf as the first case of Israel's infidelity, hinting at the weakness of the relationship.

What can be done in the aftermath of such a crisis?

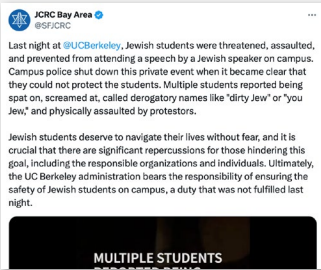
Together with punishing the main sinners, by the hands of Moses and the Levites and by a Divine plague, alongside with Moshe's arguments for the People of Israel, we learn of God's thirteen attributes of mercy. What is their role in this storyline?

Rashi presents us with one way of understanding. After Moses mustered up all his grace in the eyes of God to advocate for Israel, atone for them and promise the continuance of the Divine presence amongst them, he realizes this is a time with great potential, and he uses it as a means of getting to know God better. We can see this as a way to utilize the crisis to strengthen the relationship between man and God.

The "fight" between God and Israel, with Moses standing beside Israel, engenders a great deal of anger, but also enables a new level to this relationship, and a better understanding of both sides. Together with Moses, we too will learn of God's attributes, especially when they reappear together with the next crisis and acts of disloyalty. One can see these attributes, as a so-called exposure of vulnerability. Just as Moses revealed his vulnerability fighting for the People of Israel, God exposes his "so-called" weak points, and this brings Moses and God, but also the People of Israel and God, closer together.

Another way of understanding the role of these attributes is not as part of the reconciliation in the relationship, but as the foundation of a new covenant between the two sides. The People of Israel proved that keeping the covenant is hard for them, causing Moses to break the tablets, the evidence and content of this covenant. When God is convinced to re-establish the covenant He adds a new clause, an amendment, this time not only dictating His expectations from the People, but also expressing His renewed expectations from Himself. This time the covenant will be based upon God's mercy, an important basis, one that has a chance to last longer.

Whether the relationship between God, Moses, and Israel escalates to a new level, based on mutual understanding and (so-called) vulnerability, and whether it is reestablished on a covenantal level, including mercy alongside judgement, the Torah teaches that this unique and powerful relationship will not succumb to the crisis. It will be challenged, but it will overcome and might even emerge stronger.



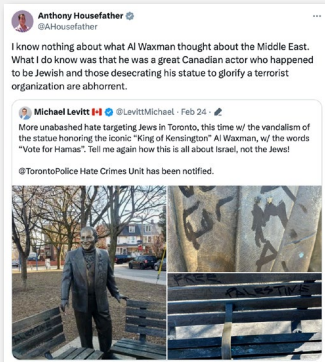

We cannot overstate the urgency of the hostages' situation in Hamas's captivity in Gaza, where they have been held for 119 days in deplorable conditions. Hamas is reportedly digging several contingency tunnels into Egypt to prepare for the escape of a large number of its upper-level commanders, members, leaders, and administrators in the event of a full Israeli ground invasion in Rafah. These contingency plans entail mass surrender to Egyptian authorities who are more likely to spare their lives and, through a political process, facilitate their release or transfer to other countries. Some of these tunnels go as deep as 15-20 meters (49-65 feet) and are prepped to have their "eyes," a local term for the tunnel's opening, to be quickly opened up on the Egyptian side when needed.
2. Yesterday, there was an explosion in Rafah near the "Salah al-Din Gate" that has been attributed to two possibilities: an unexploded Israeli bomb that somehow went off, or a failed rocket launch.
3. Private business operators, sometimes in direct cooperation with Hamas members and administrators/affiliates, hoard all sorts of supplies and food that are then sold on the market when stocks are low for high prices. This is a risky strategy because such supplies can be stolen, looted, bombed, or destroyed. We saw an example of that a few days ago in Gaza City, where an Israeli airstrike revealed the presence of food supplies that were hidden/hoarded, with starving civilians subsequently taking the supplies to feed their hungry selves and

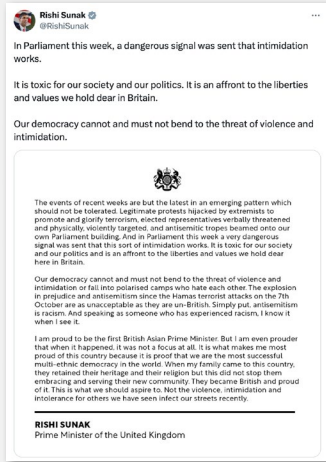

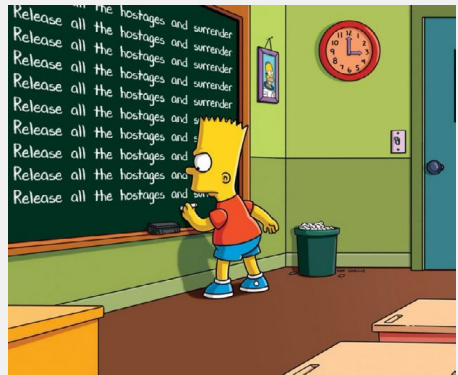

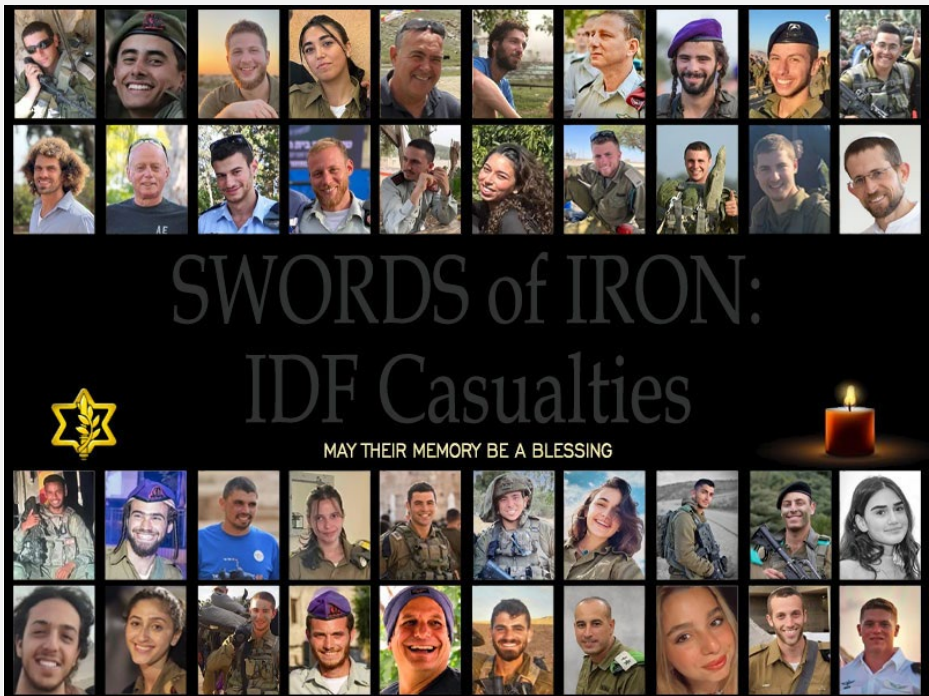
